### 1. **DEFINITIONS**

In this indenture unless the context otherwise requires;

- (a) "Trust Purpose" shall mean the object set out under Clause 6 of this indenture.
- (b) "Trust Fund" shall mean the money, money's worth, investments, securities and other assets, whether movable or immovable, from time to time vested in the Trustees and received or obtained, whether by way of donation, gift, purchase, any other form of transfer, voluntarily contribution and loan or in any other manner for the Trust purposes and any accretions or accruals thereto howsoever arising.



# 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF CHARITABLE TRUST

A Charitable Trust, which shall be known as RAMA MEMORIAL TRUST, is hereby established for the OBJECTS set out in various sub-clauses of Clause 6 hereto. Its Head Office is and shall for the time being be at Ward No. 12, Vrindaban Colony, Circus Road, Mughalsarai, Chandauli - 232101, Uttar Pradesh, or at such other place or places as the Trustees may decide from time to time and its activities shall extend throughout India.

# 4. NUCLEUS/CORPUS OF THE TRUST FUND

The Trust is being established with a nucleus (Corpus) contribution of Rs. 11000/- (Rupees Eleven Thousand only) in cash by the Settler and the Trustees have acknowledged the receipt of the same for and on behalf of the Trust.

# 5. TRUSTEES TO HOLD THE FUND IN TRUST

The Settler hereby further declares and directs that the Trust Fund, including all the receipts, acquisitions, donations, gifts, contributions or in any form of transfer and all the income, accretions and accruals thereof shall be held IN TRUST by the Trustees for all or any of the Trust Purposes or Objects set out hereafter.

#### 6. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

6.1 The main objects for which the Trust is being established shall be the economic, social, educational and spiritual betterment of human beings specially amongst downtrodden and under privileged persons of the country as also the eradication of wide-spread social evils, ailments, malpractices, selfishness, lack of civic sense and inspire the people with the pride of their rich cultural and national heritage.



- 6.2 spreading, promoting, propagating and imparting knowledge, wisdom, education and learning in all its branches by establishing, acquiring, running, maintaining and supporting Living & Learning Centers, Schools, Colleges, Study Circles, Libraries, Technical, engineering and medical institutions, Research Centers or Institutions, Universities and such other institutions imparting education, learning and training to students and others;
- 6.3 To establish or to cause to establish library in community schools or any other places by making aware to the people deprived from education due to different reasons about importance of education and to provide appropriate support to make arrangement for providing informal and formal education to those people.
- 6.4 To establish school and other educational, technical and vocational institutes for poor.
- 6.5 establishing, acquiring, running, maintaining and supporting hostels, boarding houses, mess, canteen and other such facilities for the students, trainees and learners;
- 6.6 enabling the poorest amongst the poor to avail such education or training by granting them financial and other assistance, sponsoring them for professorships, fellowships, research assistance, scholarships, free education, free boarding & messing and to do all such other activities as are felt necessary in this respect;
- 6.7 establishing, acquiring, running, maintaining and supporting, whether directly or indirectly, hospitals, dispensaries, nursing homes, maternity homes, old-age hostels, orphanages and other such public institutions and

administering medical relief to the needy, including grant of medical help to the poor and deserving persons in normal course and especially during natural calamities, disasters and distress;

6.8 To construct temple at various places and to perform the daily Pooja, Havans and Yagnas and to celebrate various festivals and functions and also for payment of salaries of Pujaris and the persons attending to the work of the trust. Furthermore, the trust will also be responsible for taking all necessary actions for the maintenance and upkeep of the temple premises.

6.9 spreading, promoting, propagating and imparting knowledge, wisdom, education and learning in all its branches by establishing, acquiring, running, maintaining and supporting Living & Learning Centers, Schools, Colleges, Study Circles, Libraries, Technical, engineering and medical institutions, Research Centers or Institutions, Universities and such other institutions imparting education, learning and training to students and others;

6.10 To spread the awareness about environmental issues and carryout plantation work for social cause.

6.11 To take- up environmental education programs for children Students, youth, women, NGOs and so on and to undertake nurseries and tree plantation program in order to safeguard the Natural resources.;

6.12 To organize free medical camps blood & eye donation programs and distribute medicines for poor.





6.13 To educate and spreading awareness amongst the public about health & hygiene;

6.14 To establish cow shelters for the protection of weak cows from slaughtering. To encourage people to keep cows and develop their breed. To conduct medicinal research on the curd ghee, cow urine, cow dung for the need of health;

6.15 To provide and distribute free medicine, clothes food items etc to helpless, poor, downtrodden and underprivileged people and tribal areas. To open special medical camps and hospitals equipped with modern medical facilities.

6.16 To carry out such works for the improvement of quality of life in backward and underdeveloped areas of the country with all round improvement in infrastructure as also in their social, economical, educational and health conditions;

6.17 To assist the people in need to undertake improved animal husbandry, cottage and small scale industries and cooperative ventures to enhance their economic condition and to effect sustainable development;

6.18 To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and/or maintenance of toilets, water filters and proper sanitation facilities in rural India;

6.19 In furtherance of its main objects as provided hereinabove, the Trust shall work for,

(a) To identify the hidden human resources among poor, disadvantaged people particularly in the

fields of Sports, Music, fine arts and other creative works and to develop the same for the respective individuals and the society at large;

- Educating and spreading awareness amongst the public about their rights and duties towards society and human being at large;
- (c) The elimination of wide-spread social evils, ailments, malpractices, greed and selfishness and improve the elements of love and sacrifice for others amongst the human beings so as to enable them to tread the path of truth and enlightenment;
- (d) The empowerment and improvement of each individual by resorting to the efforts and activities as guides, facilitators, trainers, teachers, financers and by all such other means so as to make them economically self-reliant;
- (e) To undertake programs to protect the environment and to make use of the nonconventional energy resources to profess sustainable development
- (f) To develop required infrastructure, buildings and other assets necessary to carryout the objects of this Trust;
- (g) To establish contacts with government

  Departments of both Central and State and Non –

  Government Agencies in India and aboard for

  material co operation and assistance for

exchanging views, skills, techniques and also implementing project, programmes, schemes etc. for the benefit of the people and nation and to raise and receive funds from various sources like Donations, contributions, grants, aids etc.;

- (h) establishing, acquiring, running, maintaining and supporting, whether directly or indirectly, hospitals, dispensaries, nursing homes, maternity homes, old-age hostels, orphanages and other such public institutions and administering medical relief to the needy, including grant of medical help to the poor and deserving persons in normal course and especially during natural calamities, disasters and distress;
  - (i) Imparting direct or indirect help to the needy under any circumstances, which the humanity requires and do all such acts or omissions as are desired in this respect; in India without any discrimination on account of caste, creed, race or religion.

In furtherance of the main objects as provided herein above, the Trustees shall be entitled to do all such acts directly or indirectly through Institution engaged in such activities, as may be required to be done in its regular course of activities, which also included the education and training of personnel for such objects.



# 7. ELIGIBILITY, APPOINTMENT, RETIREMENT, VACANCIES ETC. OF TRUSTEES

- 7.1 That, every male or female Indian or person of Indian origin or any other person whether Indian or otherwise having deep rooted desire for the betterment of Indians is eligible to become member of Trust provided he/she agrees with the aims and objects of the Trust and ready to abide by its rules or bye-laws as are framed by the Trust from time to time.
- 7.2 The Settler can appoint any person, who fulfills the eligibility criteria as given in Clause 7.1 hereinabove, as a Trustee of the Trust.
- 7.3 Any person who has been appointed as Trustee will continue to act as Trustee for a term of five year unless he/she/himself/herself opts for retirement or is removed by the Settler or the Trustees in the manner as provided hereafter and will be eligible for reappointment for the further term of five year and so on.
- 7.4 Any of the Trustees, including the Managing Trustee, may retire,
  - (a) on his volition or by mutual consent amongst the Trustees and /or
  - (b) by giving notice of his/her intention to retire from the Trust.
- 7.5 A Trustee shall be disqualified and shall automatically cease to be Trustee on the happening of any of the followings:
- (a) On death, resignation or retirement or on expulsion;
  - (b) On being of insane or of unsound mind;
  - (c) If he/she is adjudged insolvent or if he/she applies to be so adjudged;



- (d) If he/she is convicted of any offence (other than an offence not involving moral turpitude) and is sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than six months;
- (e) If he/she by his acts or omission intends to damage the Trust and Trust properties.

7.6 In case of any vacancy, which may be created by sad demise, retirement and expulsion or otherwise of any Trustee, will be filled up by appointment of other Trustee or Trustees and all such powers of appointment or expulsion will remain vested in the Settler till his lifetime and thereafter in the Board of Trustees.

# 8. POWERS OF TRUSTEES

The Trustees shall have and may exercise all such powers, as in their opinion, shall enable them to effectively carry out all or any of the Trust Objects. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the Trustees shall also have the power:


- (a) To apply the whole or part of the income of the Trust fund or accumulation thereof or whole or part of the corpus of the Trust fund for anyone or more of the object of the Trust as the Trustees may in their discretion from time to time determine,
- (b) To accept any donations, contributions, grant or subscriptions in cash or in kind from any person or body of persons or Trust or Society,
- (c) To convert and deal with the trust property and /
  or any investment for the time being and from

time to time in accordance with the need and convenience of the trust to fulfill / advice / advance it's objects,

- (d) To invest and kept invested the Trust Fund in conformity with the provisions of Income-tax Act, 1961, and any other law for the time being in force,
- (e) To borrow or raise or secure payments of money, to purchase, hire, take on lease or invest Trust Fund and income of Trust in moveable and immovable properties to carry on all or any of the objects of the Trust. Any income derived, accrued and received shall be solely used for aforesaid charitable purposes and no part of it shall be distributed or paid back to the settler in any of the eventualities. The sole object of such activity shall be charitable and such earnings shall only be used for aforesaid charitable purposes,
- (f) To sell, mortgage, charge, lease, hire, invest, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund,
- (g) To let out, lease or license any immovable property comprised of the Trust Fund on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit and proper,
  - (h) To open accounts with any bank or banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account, including powers to overdraw, by one





or more of the Trustees or by any agent appointed by the Trustees in this behalf,

- To adjust, settle compromise, compound and refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demand and proceedings, regarding the Trust Fund and its activities,
- (j) To appoint constitute attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys, or agents, all or any of the power vested in them under these presents and from time to time to remove such attorneys and to appoint other or others in his or their place,

(j)To appoint or make provisions for the appointment of any person/persons (including all or any of the Trustees) as Board of Trustees, Committee or Administrator or Managing Trustee or Trustees or otherwise for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate trustees to hold any property or any fund or investments, subjects to the provisions of this deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations, as the trustees may from time to time, think fit and proper,

(l) To make, vary, alter and modify Schemes, Rules and Regulations for carrying out the subjects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and functioning of any institutions in furtherance to the objects of the Trust and




otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust,

- (m) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charitable institutions for the benefits of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscriptions or donations made to such Institutions,
- (n) To set apart the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust,
- (o) To join, collaborate, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other Trust or Institutions having the same or any other public charitable objects,
- (p) To employ persons and to regulate their services in any manner including the powers to dismiss them to assist the Trustees in carrying out the Trust objects AND
- (q) To do or perform all such acts or omissions as are required for the attainment of any or all of the Trust objects,

### 9. ACCOUNTABILITIES OF TRUST AND TRUSTEES

The trustees shall be accountable only for such money, stocks, shares, properties and funds as shall actually come into their hands as trustees of the trust and the trust shall neither be answerable nor accountable for any personal neglect, default, acts or omission of the trustees nor





any banker or other persons with whom the trust properties, funds or securities may be deposited or kept.


# 10. MEETINGS OF TRUSTEES

The Trustees shall hold meetings at such intervals as they may decide. The quorum at each such meeting shall, for the time being, be 51% or three whichever is lower. The decisions in such meetings shall be taken by majority vote unless otherwise provided herein. The meetings of the Trust will be presided over by a Chairperson, who will be chosen by the Trustees present in the meeting amongst themselves and in case of division of votes he/her shall have the right to exercise his vote.

#### 11. POWERS AND DUTIES OF MANAGING TRUSTEE

The Managing Trustee shall attend to the day-to-day affairs of the Trust and shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as the Trustees may vest in him/her from time to time. The Managing Trustee is specifically authorised hereby to open and operate either singly or jointly with any other Trustee of his choice, any type of account with any of the Scheduled Banks in India or even abroad with necessary permissions from the Government of India and / or the concerned Governments.





# 12. DECISIONS BY CIRCULATION

The Trustees may also take decisions by circulation of Trust matters approved by a majority of Trustees after the matters to be so decided have been circulated to all the Trustees, then in India.


# 13. REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES AND REMUNERATION

The Trustees may be paid out of the Trust Fund, all out-of-pocket expenses, including travelling and other expenses, reasonably and legitimately incurred by them in connection with Trust matters and incurred for attending any meetings of the Trustees or any committee thereof as may be decided by the Trust. Save as aforesaid, the Trustees including the Managing Trustee shall not be entitled to any remuneration for serving as such; provided that the Trustees may employ any of the Trustees being engaged in any profession or business, or in a firm of which he shall be a member, to do any act or transact any business (whether or not an act or business which only a person engaged in that profession or business can do) and may pay such charges for the act or business done by him/her or his/her firm as aforesaid as he or they might make or recover if the Trustees or whose firm may be so employed was not a Trustee.

#### 14. AMENDMENTS

Any of the terms of this Deed including the Trust Purposes set out in Clause 6 hereof may be varied, extended or amended from time to time by an instrument in writing by the Settler during his lifetime. After the sad demise

of Settler, the Trustees shall make such variation, extension or amendment, to be approved by them in a meeting convened for that specific purpose with two-third majority of the membership of Trustees.

**PROVIDED**, that no variation, extension or amendment made by the Trustees shall be valid if it is contrary to or inconsistent with the Trust Purposes set out in Clause 6 hereof.

### 15. ACCOUNTS

The Trustees shall maintain proper and regular accounts on day-to-day basis and such books of account shall be kept at the office premises. Each Trustee shall have right to inspect such books of account during office hours. The annual accounts and statements shall be drawn and audited by a Chartered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountants who shall be appointed by the Trustees.

#### 16. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Trustees shall have all the power to frame Rules and Regulation and implement the same for the proper conduct of the affairs of the Trust, provided that such Rules and Regulations shall be consistent with the presents herein provided.

#### 17. DISSOLUTION

The Trust can be dissolved by the Settler any time during his lifetime and thereafter by an unanimous

decision of Trustees if they think it fit and proper to do so and such dissolution shall be effected by an instrument in writing under their hands and if, after all the debts and liabilities of the Trust have been paid or provided for, there shall remain any assets, the same be transferred to some other organization or association having aims or objects which in the unanimous opinion of Settler in his lifetime or thereafter the Trustees are similar to all or any of the Trust Purposes.

#### 18. OTHER RESTRICTIONS

The restrictions of Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.) in anyway must conform to the following:-

- The registrations of the school or society of the school will be renewed from time to time.
- The school management committee shall have the nominated member as per rules.
- 3. The school will have 10% reservation for the brilliant student belonging to the S.C/ST as per the Constitution of India and such student shall not be charged more than the fees set by the Madhyamic Sikha Parishad/Basic Siksha Parishad of the State where the school in functioning (e.g. If the school is set up in U.P, then the U.P Madhyamik Siksha Parishad/Basic Siksha Parishad)
- 4. The school will not ask for any grants from the State Government if the school is already affiliated to Madhyamik Siksha Parishad and in the event of the school getting its affiliation from the Central Board of Secondary Education New Delhi/Council of Indian Certificate Examination, New Delhi all previous affiliation of grants being enjoyed by the school shall stand annulled and cancelled from the date of such affiliation'



- 5. The schools' teaching and non teaching staff will avail salary and wages not below the norm set by the Institutions funded by the State Government'
- 6. The service rules and retirement benefits of the staff will be set as per norms of non Govt. Aided Senior Secondary Schools'
- The ordered issued by the State Government and other authorities from time to time will be followed by the school.
- The school will maintain records and registers as per prescribed and approved format.
- There will be no amendment/ rectification/ extension
  of the above mentioned conditions without prior
  concert of the State Government of the state where the
  school will function'
